**RE: Article V, Combination Road-Yard, 1964 UTU National Agreement**

Sir,

Our office would request that the Carrier comply with the UTU 1964 National Agreement, Article V, and that a joint study be implemented immediately at Erwin Yard in Erwin Tennessee concerning the Carrier's attempt to eliminate the last remaining yard assignment at this location.

The 1985 UTU L&N National Agreement, Article 49 outlines the requirements for this 30 day study that must be conducted. I am requesting a yard assignment to be put on immediately for this 30 day study to be handled by a manager of the Carrier's choosing and our SMART-TD Local Chairman Phil Terry at Erwin.

Our office would also inquire about the Washington Protection afforded in this Article of the Agreement and how it would apply to all trainmen at this location, especially to those prior right protected and protected trainmen, with the Carrier's intentions to eliminate the yard assignments at this location?
